#### **Mission Statement**

- 2.5 grade point average or higher
- Planning to attend a 2- or 4-year college/university in the Fall of 2017

#### **Application**

- Must be received no later than March 15, 2017
- Must attach two letters of recommendation
- Must include essay

## Award

The recipient will be announced in May 2017. The recipient will receive the award for the next semester at the time they enter the college/university stated on their application and upon receipt by the Dallas JPA of the scholarship recipient's proof of registration.
