## **Dallas Junior Police Academy**

The Dallas Junior Police Academy "ADVANCED" Class is a full-day learning experience sponsored by the Dallas Police Department. The purpose of this event is to provide education/information to the students who attend. Those attending will leave with a realistic view of law enforcement and the opportunities a career in law enforcement would afford. During the day, the students will enjoy a "hands on" experience of the Police Academy and have one-on-one interaction with law enforcement professionals.

You will be notified when the student's application has been accepted to participate in the Dallas Junior Police Academy <u>"ADVANCED"</u> Class. If you have NOT been notified, your child is not able to attend this class. You will need to reapply for the next class.

The class will be held on Saturday, February 3, 2018. Fifty students will be selected for the class. All students must be in the 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade. Classes will be held in the Media Conference Room at the Jack Evans Dallas Police Academy Headquarters, 1400 South Lamar, Dallas, Texas 75215.

## IF YOU ARE A NO SHOW FOR THE CLASS, YOU WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO ATTEND ANOTHER CLASS FOR ONE YEAR.

Students are to wear school-appropriate attire: shirts with inappropriate language, shorts, sandals, flip-flops or tank tops WILL NOT BE PERMITTED. Students will be outside part of the day and should dress accordingly, including comfortable walking/exercise shoes. If the student has any food allergies, they should be noted on the application. If the student requires any medication during the day, the parent/guardian should bring it to the class at check-in and advise the instructors. All students will be required to check in between 8:00 AM and 8:30 AM. The Academy will begin at 9:00 AM. Lunch will be provided. At 4:45 PM, parents are invited to attend the graduation of their students from the "ADVANCED" Dallas Junior Police Academy. The graduation will conclude at 5:30 PM, and certificates will be awarded. There will also be special prizes for the students.

Transportation is not provided. Upon arrival, parents/guardians will be responsible for registering their child and providing verification of transportation at the end of the day. No child will be allowed to leave with anyone other than their parent/guardian without prior written approval from their parent/guardian and showing the proper ID at the time of pickup.
